All documents, returned for refund, must be received complete, in good condition and within thirty (30) days of the Bid Opening.

Each bidder must deposit with his bid, security in the amount, form and subject to the conditions provided in the Information for Bidders.

Attention of bidders is particularly called to the requirements as to conditions of employment to be observed and minimum wage rates to be paid under the Contract. In addition, there is a MWBE participation goal for HIGHLAND SAND/SALT BUILDING CONTRACT NO. 1 –GENERAL in the amount of \$124,950 based upon full utilization of the available grant funds.

BIDDERS OF THIS WORK WILL BE REQUIRED TO COMPLY WITH THE PRESIDENT'S EXECUTIVE ORDERS #11246, #10925 AND #11375. THE REQUIREMENTS FOR BIDDERS AND CONTRACTORS UNDER THIS ORDER, WHICH CONCERNS NON-DISCRIMINATION IN EMPLOYMENT, ARE EXPLAINED IN THE SPECIFICATIONS.
