

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE: Upon becoming aware of issues concerning the Town of Highland Constables, the Town of Highland Town Board on April 12, 2022, unanimously adopted a Resolution temporarily suspending the activities of the Town of Highland Constables. Since that time, the Town Board, through its Constable Committee, has conducted a number of interviews and has had discussions to investigate these issues. They have also met with various law enforcement experts to review the most effective law enforcement procedures for the Town of Highland to implement. Also, there has been a number of recent changes implemented by the State concerning policing procedures which will need to be adopted by the Town.

The Sullivan County Sheriff's Office and New York State Police have, in the interim, provided additional law enforcement coverage within the Town for which the Town is grateful.

The Town Board will shortly be implementing new guidelines and procedures to be utilized by law enforcement personnel within the Town of Highland.

The Town of Highland Town Board is fully committed to providing all of the residents of the Town of Highland, and its visitors, with the most up to date law enforcement protection. This will include utilizing the most up to date policing policies and training. The Town Board takes its responsibility to provide for the safety of the Town most seriously and is in the process of completing its review.
